Good attendance is vital to your child's learning and progress. Research shows that children with high attendance achieve better academically, build stronger social relationships, and are more confident in their learning. Even a small amount of absence can have a significant impact on a child's progress, for example, overall attendance of 90% equates to nearly four full weeks of missed school in a year.

We understand that illness and unavoidable circumstances can sometimes affect attendance. However, it is essential that these occasions are kept to a minimum and that the school is notified as soon as possible if your child is unable to attend.
