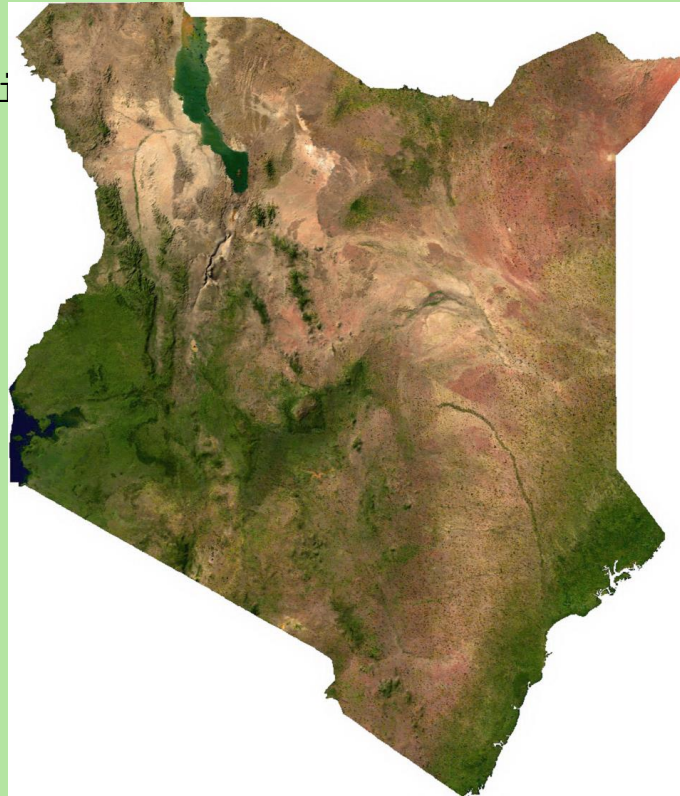
The school is in Kenya (continent: Africa)

Here is an ariel photograph of Kenya. Look at the land. Does it look like England?

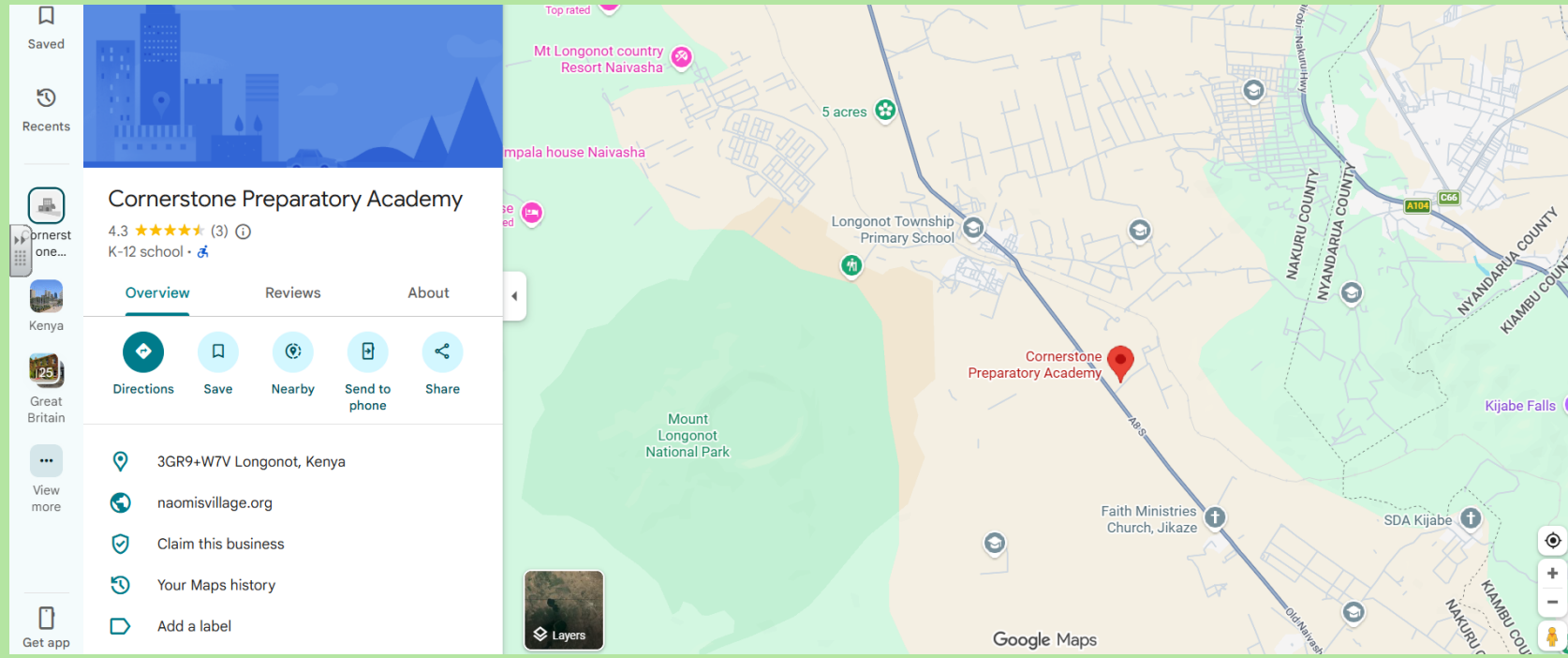


Map of the continent Africa with Kenya in orange.

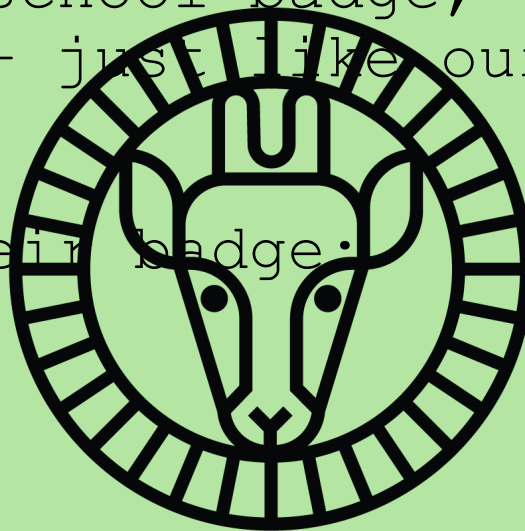
Drop the little yellow person on to the nearest road to the school - let's see what the landscape and physical features look like...
